A successful researcher and author, Dr. Martin has contributed seven papers to the <u>Proceedings</u> of the <u>Southwest Decision Sciences Institute</u> and two papers to the <u>Proceedings</u> of the national organization. Additionally he has served as paper reviewer, session chair, and discussant more than a dozen times each for SWDSI. He has also served as a frequent reviewer and discussant for the national DSI meetings.
